We hope to display as many photos as possible, but we cannot guarantee that your photo will be displayed, depending on the available space. This display will remain through the month of May.

GETTING PARKING TICKETS IN THE CITY OF HAWAIIAN GARDENS

When you receive a parking ticket from the City of Hawaiian Gardens the following options are available to you:

1. Mail payment, including the ticket, within 21 days of citation date, to:

Attn: Parking Citation Clerk
2. Pay Citation in person within 30 days of citation date at the address listed above.
3. Contest the ticket in person within 10 days of

citation date at address listed above, which will then take approximately two weeks to process.

4. Pay Citation over the phone by credit card by calling: (800) 654-7275.

Note: Mailed payments must be in check or money order form only and include the citation number – no cash will be accepted unless paying in person at the address listed above. You may not pay tickets from other cities at Hawaiian Gardens City Hall. All late payments must be mailed to: Parking Administrators, PO Box 4726, Irvine, CA 92716-4726.

WE-TIP

Recently, some citizens of Hawaiian Gardens have expressed a concern about providing information of crimes occurring within the city and remaining anonymous.

The WE-TIP hotline is set up exactly for this, utilizing toll free numbers. That means you can provide the crime information without any cost to yourself. When you call the hotline the operator will specifically tell you not to give your name. You will then be asked a series of questions important to law enforcement regarding the crime you are reporting. The WE-TIP hotline numbers are good for any crime (drugs, robbery, vandalism, arson, illegal weapons, burglary, crimes against children, etc.). Once the information has been given to the WE-TIP hotline, it is passed on to the appropriate police, fire, and sheriff's agencies.
