Summary of the actions taken at the City Council meeting

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Ordinance No. 2023-610

Second reading of Ordinance adopting the Fire Code of the Los Angeles County Code, incorporating the California Fire Code, 2022 Edition, with certain changes and amendments.

Ordinance No. 2023-611

First reading of Ordinance imposing regulations on sidewalk vending in compliance with Senate Bill 946 and 972.

CITY CLERK

Cancelled Meeting

Cancelled the regular Public Housing Authority meeting and City Council meeting of Tuesday, June 27, 2023.

Resolution No. 024-2023

Adopted Resolution amending the Sister City Travel and Donation Policy to clarify the policy on donations in excess of policy limitations.

Donation

Approved a monetary donation to our Sister City of Venustiano Carranza, Michoacan, Mexico, to complete the remodeling of restrooms at one of the local schools - Escuela Primaria Venustiano Carranza.

PUBLIC WORKS

Pioneer Park Renovation

Approve construction plans and specifications for the Pioneer Park Renovation, removing and replacing the existing playground equipment and rubberized surface, and installation of new lighting for the park sign.

Resolution No. 022-2023

Adopted resolution ordering the levy and collection of assessments within the City of Hawaiian Gardens Consolidated Landscaping and Lighting District No. HGLLA1 for Fiscal Year 2023-2024, the adopted resolution provides for the continued funding of street lighting and landscape maintenance throughout the City of Hawaiian Gardens

Resolution No. 023-2023

Adopted resolution identifying the Street Improvement Projects and adopting the list of Projects for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 funded by SB-1: SB-1 provides additional state funding to address basic road maintenance, rehabilitation, and critical safety needs on highways and local streets, which is funded by a per gallon fuel tax and vehicle registration fees.

Resolution No. 019-2023

Adopted resolution authorizing the recording of liens against various real properties in the City for delinquent rubbish collection charges due to Waste Resources, Inc.

Resolution No. 021-2023

Adopted resolution adopting a two-year budget for the fiscal years of 2023-2024 and 2024-2025.

Resolution No. 020-2023
