Summary of the actions taken at the City Council meeting

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Ordinance No. 2023-612

Second reading of Ordinance relating to an expedited, streamlined permitting process for electric vehicle charging stations. This Ordinance will bring the City's permitting processes for EV Charging stations in line with State law.

Letters of Opposition

Staff will send letters of opposition signed by the Mayor to Assemblywoman Sharon Quirk-Silva, regarding AB 309, which disregards the statemandated planning process and specifically empowers the Department of General Services to make land use and zoning decisions on state excess property; and to Senator Janet Nguyen, regarding SB 423, which would take away local control and force cities to ministerially approve certain housing projects without obtaining input from the community.
