The HSIP Cycle 8 Carson Street Signal Hardware Improvements, Project 106. The project consists of improvements to signal hardware system at eight (8) intersections along Carson Street from Pioneer Boulevard to Bloomfield Avenue.

The HSIP Cycle 8 Norwalk Boulevard Signal Hardware Improvements, Project 107. The project includes improvements to signal hardware system at four (4) intersection locations along Norwalk Boulevard from 214th Street to 226th Street.
