Summary of the actions taken at the City Council meeting

CITY ATTORNEY

Resolution No. 038-2023

Approved an Amendment to the Flexible Benefit Plan; Adopts a Health Reimbursement Arrangement; Approves the retention of MidAmerica Administrative & Retirement Solutions. This Resolution is the first step in ensuring that the terms of the City's bargaining agreements are properly implemented.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Resolution No. 032-2023

Extended the deadline to establish an online permitting system for post-entitlement phase permits to January 1, 2026

Ordinance No. 2023-613

Second reading of Ordinance to set parameters for the operation of mobile food vending operations (also called food trucks) within the City by adding Chapter 5.97 of Title 5 of the HGMC.

FINANCE

Warrants Processed

Received and filed warrants processed during the period of October 14, 2023 to November 3, 2023.

HUMAN RESOURCES

Salary Adjustments for Neighborhood Counselor and Special Events Coordinator positions

Salaries were increased to meet the salary requirements for an exempt position under California law.

PUBLIC SAFETY

Resolution No. 035-2023

Adopted resolution to declare Unit 43 (2008 Ford Escape Hybrid) as surplus.

PUBLIC WORKS

Military and Veterans Parking Signs

Approved to designate one parking stall at each of the City's five public parking lots (City Hall, Senior Center, Recreation Center, Lee Ware Recreation Center, and Fedde Sports Complex) for specific use of our Active Military personnel and veterans.

RECREATION

Resolution No. 037-2023

Authorized the Service and Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages at C. Robert Lee Activity Center during the December 2, 2023 Boxing Event.
