Summary of the actions taken at the City Council meeting

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Resolution No. 006-2024

Adopted Resolution No. 006-2024, for the city to join the Gateway Cities Affordable Housing Trust (Trust), a Joint Powers Authority (JPA) formed among the cities within the Gateway Cities region. The Trust provides funding to preserve and produce affordable housing.

FINANCE

Warrants Processed

Received and filed warrants processed during the period of February 17, 2024 to March 1, 2024.

Treasurer's Report

Received and filed the Treasurer's Report for October, November, and December 2023.

PUBLIC WORKS

Carson Street Beautification Phase II, Project 108

Approved plans and specifications and authorized the Public Works Manager to seek public bids for Carson Street Beautification Phase II, Project 108 – from Norwalk Boulevard to Bloomfield Avenue. Phase II of the Carson Street Beautification mirrors phase I of Carson Street – Streetscape Improvement.

Citywide Bicycle Master Plan

Awarded agreement to Toole Design Group for preparation of a Citywide Bicycle Master Plan. The Plan will be consistent with the City's existing General Plan and Complete Streets policies, and will include public outreach, and the development of detailed system maps. The goal of the project is to update the City's existing bike route system for development of a convenient transportation alternative to motor vehicles for residents, visitors, and commuters.

PUBLIC WORKS CONT.

Citywide Catch Basin Connector Pipe Screen Inserts Installation, Project 111

Approved plans and specifications and authorized the Public Works Manager to seek public bids for cleaning out existing catch basins, and furnishing and installing Connector Pipe Screen Inserts in 118 City and County owned catch basins.
