Surplus Equipment

Declared the 1996 MQ Whisperwatt Generator with trailer and 2004 Tennant 6650 Sweeper as surplus; After years of use, they were earmarked for replacement as parts became obsolete, increased repair costs, and both became unreliable with frequent breakdowns.

MuniEnvironmental Agreement

Extended the Professional Services Agreement with MuniEnvironmental Professional Consultants, for a period of three years, to perform solid waste and recycling consulting services.

CITY COUNCIL

Resolution No. 007-2024

Adopted Resolution opposing Initiative No. 21-0042A1, the Taxpayer Protection and Government Accountability Act. The initiative converts administratively imposed fines and penalties into taxes unless a new, undefined, and ambiguous "adjudicatory due process" is followed. This provision may put at risk authority to impose fines and penalties for violations of state and local law.
