

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The City of Hawaiian Gardens is developing a Bicycle Master Plan for the first time. During its development, the City will study streets and paths to identify design elements that help improve safety and mobility needs. The Plan will also help improve bicycle connections with neighboring cities and prioritize proposed improvements. Once complete, the Plan will serve as a roadmap to improve bicycle safety and infrastructure in the city for the next 10 years.



Why is the Bicycle Master Plan Important?

The Bicycle Master Plan will help the City identify challenges with bicycle travel today and propose improvements that will make Hawaiian Gardens a safer and more comfortable place to ride a bike. It will also increase the City's chances of securing additional funding for these improvements.

The Bicycle Master Plan also benefits the community in many ways including:



Improving safety for current and future bicycle riders of all ages and abilities



Reducing car dependency



Encouraging more physical activity



Improving connectivity and access to destinations across the city
